Notes for financial form:

1. Travel costs are incurred by sending our conference rep. to Chicago for meetings with WM of the ECC; getting the Canadian leadership team together to plan;

2. Administration costs involve such things as delegate fees for conference and office type expenses.
3. Denominational support is to help operate the WM office in Chicago.
4. Educate the Girls is an on going project that can be supported through the Paul Carlson Foundation. This is to fund exam expenses for girls in Congo.
5. Canada is continuing its support of AVA through the work of Karen Bailey of Strathmore. We continue to fund travel and resources for her as she trains people in the Canadian Covenant.
6. The Denominational Project is Break the Chains. A similar project in Bolivia, for which Canadian women can be receipted, is another option.
7. The Connections Newsletter is a biyearly publication of information for Canadian WM.
8. The Legacy Fund is to continue to show support for those wishing to attend a school of Discipleship and Biblical Study. (similar to former bursary fund)
9. Money is raised to help a spouse of an ordinand attend the annual meeting of the ECC to be part of his or her spouse's ordination; the worship enhancement fund gives money to any new Covenant work to buy worship materials.
10. Missionary Encouragement Fund aids people doing project missionary work; Special Interest Missionaries have projects that we help support; Raise the Flag is a fund for bringing women from other countries to Triennial and this is ongoing as the funds needed are significant and a three year window is open to us. The Congo shipping fund is to send bandages and other supplies to Congo. These costs have gone up significantly.
11. Ministry Coaches are not yet trained for Canada but are to be women that will help start or revitalize WM groups in our conference. Faith and Action Outreach Grants fund initiatives that are new and aimed at growth.
